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Care and Cleaning of Your Cultured Marble Vanity Tops

The following simple precautions and care guidelines will help you keep your cultured marble vanity tops looking like new to ensure many years of enjoyment.

How to Clean Your Cultured Marble Vanity Tops...

1. Cultured marble should be cleaned regularly with a non-abrasive household cleaner. Use products that are appropriate for use on glass, windows, and mirrors. Avoid harsh chemicals and abrasive cleaners as these can cause permanent damage to the finish. Also, avoid using products containing ammonia or bleach.

Care of Your Cultured Marble Vanity Tops...

1. The gel coat on cultured marble not only adds beauty to the surface, it also seals the surface making it waterproof. It prevents staining as well as growth of bacteria and mold. This gel coat can be damaged by deep scratches, excessive scouring and cleaning with abrasive products.
2. The surface should not be exposed to strong chemicals such as acids, acetone based nail polish removers, paint thinners, bleach, hair coloring products, etc. If any of these products are spilled on the surface, the surface should be immediately flushed with clean water.
3. Avoid placing hot irons, curling irons, or other hot items directly on the surface as they will damage the finish.
4. Exposure to water temperatures above 150 degrees Fahrenheit can cause the bowl to crack and will void the warranty.
